PROCEDURAL RULES of the Qualifying and Final Stages of the Interregional Subject Olympiads of Kazan (Volga Region) Federal University for 2024/2025 Academic Year



1. General Provisions

The present Procedural Rules are developed in accordance with Part 3 of Article 77 of the Federal Law No. 273-FZ of December 29, 2012 "On Education in the Russian Federation", in accordance with the Order of the Olympiad for School Students, approved by Order of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation of No. 566 of June 22, 2022, Regulations on Interregional Subject Olympiads of Federal State Autonomous Educational Institution of Higher Education "Kazan (Volga Region) Federal University" No. 0.1.1.67-08/47/2024 of August 27, 2024 (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) and determines the order and terms of participation in the Interregional Subject Olympiads of Kazan (Volga Region) Federal University (hereinafter referred to as the Olympiads) in the academic year 2024/25.

2. General Procedure for the Olympiads

- 2.1. The Olympiads are held in two stages:
- The qualifying stage, which is held in distant mode with the use of distance learning technologies;
- the final stage, which is held in person, including with the use of distance education technologies that ensure real-time identification of the participants of the final stage of the Olympiads and control of their compliance with the conditions and requirements for the Olympiads, established by the organizer of the Olympiads.
 - 2.2. All stages of the Olympiads are held in the subjects listed in Appendix 1 hereto.
- 2.3. The Olympiads shall be held on a voluntary basis among students of the 5th-11th grades of general educational organizations mastering educational programs of basic general and secondary general education, as well as among persons mastering these educational programs in the form of family education, self-education or abroad, and students mastering educational programs of secondary vocational education in the field of Arts.
- 2.4. General information is published on the official website for the Olympiads:
 - for citizens of the Russian Federation https://malun.kpfu.ru/mpo (hereinafter referred to as the Olympiad website);
 - for foreign citizens https://malun.kpfu.ru/mpo/fc (hereinafter referred to as the Olympiad website for foreign citizens)

3. Registration of Participants

- 3.1. Participants shall register distantly on the website for the Olympiads and the Olympiad website for foreign citizens.
- 3.2. Upon registration, a login and password for entering the personal account, as well as the ID number of the Olympiad participant are formed. Participants are not allowed to give their login, password and ID-number to third parties. Participants are obliged to keep their login, password and ID-number until the end of the Olympiad.
- 3.3. To participate in the Olympiad, the participant should fill in all fields of the tabs "About me", "Address and passport" in his/her personal profile and sign the Consent for processing personal data.
- 3.4. In the personal account the participant fills in the electronic forms in Russian. Foreign citizens, participants of the Olympiad, shall fill in the personal account in English in exact accordance with the passport (in case of absence of the passport it is allowed to fill in exact accordance with the passport of the citizen of the country) and in Russian in exact accordance with the passport (in case of absence of the passport it is allowed to fill in exact accordance with the passport of the citizen of the country). The participant is responsible for the completeness and accuracy

of the data provided by him/her in the registration form. It is forbidden to fill in the data with the Caps Lock key pressed. Claims related to incorrect or incomplete data filling in the personal cabinet of the participant or technical problems arising during the remote registration are not accepted or considered by the Organizing Committee after the end of the registration for the final stage. In case of detection of incomplete or unreliable information, the Organizing Committee may decide to disqualify the participant.

3.5. Participant who took part in the Olympiads in previous years can use his/her personal account without re-registration for the 2024/25 academic year, provided that his/her personal data are updated. The Organizing Committee will not accept or consider any claims related to the fact that the personal account data have not been updated after the end of registration for the final stage. In case of detection of incomplete or unreliable information, the Organizing Committee may decide to disqualify the participant.

4. Procedure for the Qualifying Stage of the Olympiad for citizens of the Russian Federation

- 4.1. Participants of the Qualifying Stage shall complete tasks in distant mode during one session from 08:00 on November 1, 2024 to 23:59 on November 29, 2024 (Moscow time).
- 4.2. The Qualifying Stage in Computer Science will be held online in PCMS testing system after the registration on website for the Olympiads. Tasks are posted in three packages of 5 tasks each and are available from the time of posting until the end of the Qualifying Stage. The score for the Qualifying Stage is calculated as a sum of points received for all 3 packages of tasks.

Dates of publishing the packages:

- Package No. 1 November 1, 2024;
- Package No. 2 November 11, 2024;
- Package No. 3 November 20, 2024.

To check the task participants should send the source codes of the program, which are checked on a set of tests, and, based on the number of tests passed, points are awarded for each task. A participant can get a maximum of 100 points for each task. Maximum score for 3 packages of tasks is 1500 points.

The list of available compilers in the testing system: C++, Java, Python, Pascal.

- 4.3. The Qualifying Stage in Design is held in the form of a creative task. During the Qualifying Stage, specified in paragraph 4.1, the participant shall complete the task in accordance with the instructions to the task and upload it in electronic form in the personal account. The work is uploaded once in the "Qualifying stage" tab in the personal profile, and only single file is allowed to be uploaded. The work must not contain any marks not related to the task or indicating the authorship of the work (including in the file name). In case of non-compliance with these requirements, the Organizing Committee has the right to cancel the work.
- 4.4. In case of a technical failure, the participant can log in to the Olympiad system again, if the set time of the task has not expired.
- 4.5. In case of a technical failure that deprived the participant of the opportunity to participate in the Olympiad through no fault of his/her own, the participant has the right to send a written appeal to the Organizing Committee to the e-mail mpo@kpfu.ru within three working days after the failure and not later than on the day of publication of the ranking lists. In this appeal it is necessary to describe the incident in detail and attach supporting documents (screenshot of the computer screen, photo and other documents with the error message). Provided that the Organizing Committee recognizes the reason of technical failure as valid, the Organizing Committee will assist the participant to participate in the Olympiad again.
- 4.6. Any registered participant can complete the tasks for each selected profile only once. If a participant has completed the tasks more than once for one Olympiad profile, the first result in terms of time will be counted in the rating table.

- 4.7. The duration of the qualifying stage session for each profile is counted from the moment of pressing the "Start testing" button and is specified in Appendix 1 to these Regulations.
- 4.8. If the participant does not press the 'Finish and submit for checking' button after completing the tasks, the result will be counted as 0 points.
- 4.9. From December 2, 2024 the answers to the Olympiad tasks are available in the personal accounts of the participants on the Olympiad website
- 4.10. The ranking lists of participants for each profile shall be published no later than 23:59 on December 6, 2024.
- 4.11. Applications for appeal will be accepted from the period from December 7 to 9, 2024 in the personal account.
- 4.12. Final results of the qualifying stage will be published on the Olympiad website no later than 23:59 on December 17, 2024.
- 4.13. Winners and prize-winners of the qualifying stage are determined on the basis of the rating table of the Olympiad participants, formed on the basis of the sum of points received by the participant for fulfilment of the Olympiad tasks, taking into account the results of an appeal.
- 4.14. The total number of winners and prize-winners of the qualifying stage of the Olympiads shall not exceed 45% of the total number of participants in the relevant profile.
- 4.15. Ranking lists and final results of the qualifying stage of the Olympiads for all profiles are published on the Olympiads website, according to the ID numbers of the participants.
- 4.16. Participants of the qualifying stage who were not among the winners and runners-up receive certificates of participation in electronic form.
- 4.17. Winners and prize-winners of the qualifying stage of the Olympiads receive diplomas of the winner/prizewinner of the qualifying stage of the Olympiads in electronic form.

5. Procedure of the qualifying stage of the Olympiads for foreign citizens

- 5.1. The qualifying stage of the Olympiad shall be held in the form of distance learning tasks in one session from 08:00 on December 2, 2024 till 23:59 of January 8, 2025 (Moscow time).
- 5.2. The qualifying stage for the 'Design' profile is held in the form of a creative task. During the period of the qualifying stage specified in clause 4.1, the participant performs the work in accordance with the instructions to the task and uploads the completed work in electronic form to his/her personal cabinet. In the personal cabinet in the tab 'Qualifying stage' the work is uploaded once, one file is allowed to be uploaded. There must not be any marks in the work, not related to the task or indicating the authorship of the work (including in the file name). In case of non-compliance with these requirements, the Organizing Committee has the right to cancel the work.
- 5.3. In case of a technical failure, the participant can log in to the Olympiad system again, if the set time of the task has not expired.
- 5.4. In case of a technical failure that deprived the participant of the opportunity to participate in the Olympiad through no fault of his/her own, within three working days after the failure and not later than on the day of publication of the ranking lists, the participant has the right to send a written appeal to the Organising Committee by e-mail to the following address Inter-olympiad@kpfu.ru a written appeal. In this appeal it is necessary to describe the incident in detail and attach supporting documents (screenshot of the computer screen, photo and other documents with the error message). If the Organising Committee recognises the reason for the technical failure as valid, the Organising Committee will assist the participant to participate in the Olympiad again.
- 5.5. Any registered participant can complete the tasks for each selected profile only once. If a participant has completed the tasks more than once for one Olympiad profile, the first result in terms of time will be counted in the ranking table
- 5.6. The duration of the qualifying stage session for each profile is counted from the moment of pressing the 'Start testing' button and is specified in Appendix 1 to these Regulations.
- 5.7. If the participant does not press the 'Finish and submit for checking' button after completing the tasks, the result will be counted as 0 points.

- 5.8. From January 9, 2025 in the personal accounts of the participants on the website of the Olympiads for foreign citizens the answers to the Olympiad tasks are available
- 5.9. Without any of the above documents a participant is not allowed to participate in the Final Stage of the Olympiad. The ranking lists of participants for each profile shall be published no later than 23:59 on January 13, 2025
- 5.10. Applications for appeal will be accepted from the period of January 14 to 16, 2025 in the personal account.
- 5.11. Final results of the qualifying stage are published on the website of the Olympiads for Foreign Citizens no later than 23:59 on January 20, 2025.
- 5.12. Winners and prize-winners of the qualifying stage are determined on the basis of the rating table of the Olympiad participants, formed on the basis of the sum of points received by the participant for fulfilment of the Olympiad tasks, taking into account the results of an appeal.
- 5.13. The total number of winners and prize-winners of the qualifying stage of the Olympiads shall not exceed 45% of the total number of participants in the respective profile.
- 5.14. Ranking lists and final results of the qualifying stage of the Olympiads for all profiles are published on the website of the Olympiads for foreign citizens according to the ID numbers of the participants.
- 5.15. Participants of the qualifying stage who were not among the winners and prize-winners receive certificates of participation in electronic form.
- 5.16. Winners and prize-winners of the qualifying stage of the Olympiads receive diplomas of the winner/prizewinner of the qualifying stage of the Olympiads in electronic form.

6. The Procedure for Conducting the Final Stage of the Olympiads in the Venues

- 6.1. The final stage of the Olympiads shall be held from January 10 to February 2, 2025 in accordance with the schedule of the Olympiads approved by the order of the Rector of KFU. The schedule of the final stage shall be published on the Olympiads website no later than 23:59 on 6 December 2024.
- 6.2. The start and end of all events of the Olympiads are indicated in the timetable of the Olympiads, Moscow time.
- 6.3. The winners and prize-winners of the qualifying stage of the Olympiads of the current academic year are allowed to participate in the final stage of the Olympiads:
 - winners and prize-winners of the qualifying stage of the Olympiads of the current academic year;
 - winners and prize-winners of the final stage of the Olympiads of the previous academic year in the relevant profile, who continue to master general education programs of basic general and secondary general education, including in the form of family education or self-education, who master the above educational programs abroad, as well as who master educational programs of secondary professional education in the field of arts, bypassing the qualifying stage of the current Olympiad.
- 6.4. Participants are admitted to the final stage upon presentation of the originals of the following documents:
- a. identity document: passport (if over 14 years of age) or school certificate with the participant's photo (if under 14 years of age);
- 6. the cover page of the final stage participant's work, printed from the personal account on the Olympiad website, with the following information:
- Participant ID number;
- full name in full in exact accordance with the identity documents;
- date of birth;
- contact phone number;
- SNILS number (Personal Insurance Policy Number);



- number and series of the identity document (passport of a citizen of the Russian Federation/birth certificate);
- name of the settlement and educational organisation (including for the participants mastering general education programmes of basic general and secondary general education in the form of family education);
- city of the full-time stage.
- 6.5. For the participants of the final stage until December 27, 2024 (inclusive), a remote procedure for selecting a city of participation in the final stage is organised in their personal accounts. Participants who have not chosen a city of participation and who arrive at the venue of the final stage without prior notification of the Organising Committee will not be guaranteed a workplace
- 6.6. The final stage in the 'Informatics' profile is conducted in the PCMS testing system, in which 5 tasks will be placed. To test a task, the source codes of the programme are sent, which are checked on a set of tests, and, based on the number of passed tests, points are given for the task. A participant can get a maximum of 100 points for each task. List of available compilers in the testing system: C++, Java, Python, Pascal.

7. Procedure of the final stage of the Olympiads for foreign citizens Olympiad final stage for foreign citizens

- 7.1. The final stage of the Olympiad shall be held from March 3 to March 9, 2025 in accordance with the Olympiad schedule approved by the order of the Rector of KFU. The schedule of the final stage is published on the website of the Olympiads for foreign citizens not later than 23:59 on January 20, 2025.
- 7.2. The start and end of all the events of the Olympiads are indicated in the timetable of the Olympiads, Moscow time.
- 7.3. The winners and prize-winners of the qualifying stage of the Olympiads of the current academic year are allowed to participate in the final stage of the Olympiads.
- 7.4. Participants are admitted to the final stage upon presentation of the originals of the following documents:
- a. identity document;
- 6. the title page of the final stage participant's work, printed from the personal account on the Olympiad website for foreign citizens, indicating the following information:
- full name in English in exact accordance with the foreign passport (in case of absence of a foreign passport it is allowed to fill in in exact accordance with the passport of a citizen of the country);
- full name in Russian in exact accordance with the notarised translation of the foreign passport (in case of absence of a foreign passport, it is allowed to fill in in exact accordance with the passport of a citizen of the country);
- date of birth;
- contact phone number;
- number of the foreign passport (in case of absence of the foreign passport it is allowed to fill in the number of the passport of the citizen of the country);
- country, name of the settlement and educational organisation;
- city of the full-time stage.
- 7.5. For the participants of the final stage until January 30, 2025 (inclusive), a remote procedure for choosing the format of participation in the final stage is organised in their personal accounts. Participants who do not choose a city of participation and come to the venue of the final stage without prior notification of the Organising Committee are not guaranteed a workplace

8. Procedure of the final stage of the Olympiads at the venues of the Olympiads

Kazan (Volga Region)

- 8.1. The venues of the final stage of the Olympiads shall be approved by the order of KFU.
- 8.2. Official representatives of KFU from among the employees of the main structural divisions of KFU are appointed by the order of KFU to organise the final stage of the Olympiads in the venues of the Olympiads.
- 8.3. Official representatives of KFU receive delivery packs with tasks and handouts for each Olympiad participant from the Organising Committee of the Olympiads on the profile of the final stage.
- 8.4. The delivery pack contains the tasks for each profile of the final stage. The handout contains the following forms: tasks, form No. 1 for answers, form No. 2 for answers, draft form.
- 8.5. The delivery package is opened by the official representative of KFU at the venue of the final stage of the Olympiads in the presence of the participants of the Olympiads.
- 8.6. The completed works by the KFU official representative are collected in separate packages by profile and sealed.
- 8.7. The final stage of the Olympiads shall be completed by drawing up a report on the Olympiads, indicating the date and venue of the Olympiads and the number of participants. If necessary, an act on the violations revealed in the process of organising and conducting the final stage of the Olympiads shall be filled in. The acts shall be signed by the official representative of KFU.
- 8.8. Completed works are collected and sealed by KFU officials and delivered to the Organising Committee for encryption and submission to the Jury.
- 8.9. Officials are personally responsible for the safety and non-disclosure of assignments they receive from the Organising Committee.

9. Rules of behaviour of participants during the final stage of the Olympiads

- 9.1. The duration of the final stage of the Olympiads for each profile is specified in Appendix 1 to these Regulations.
- 9.2. On the day of the final stage of the Olympiads, the participants arrive at the venue no later than 40 minutes before the start of the Olympiads to be placed in the classrooms and to be briefed.
- 9.3. The answer form and sheets for rough notes will be given to the participants in the classroom. The use of paper brought by the participants or provided by other persons is not allowed.
- 9.4. Participants who are not more than 30 minutes late for the start of the Olympiad have the right to take part in the Olympiad, but the time for them will not be extended. Participants who are more than 30 minutes late are not allowed to take part in the OlympiadE-mail: mpo@kpfu.ru.
- 9.5. In the event of unforeseen circumstances (such as force majeure, unfavourable sanitary and epidemiological situation in the country, introduction of special regimes, etc.) that are an obstacle to the Olympiad, the Organising Committee may decide to change the start and completion times of the Olympiad tasks performed by the participants of the final stage (provided that the necessary measures to protect the confidentiality of the Olympiad tasks are observed) or to cancel the Olympiad.
- 9.6. During the Olympiad the participants are prohibited to communicate and exchange any materials, items and tasks, to cheat themselves and allow cheating from themselves, to stand up without the permission of the organisers, to have with themselves and at their workplace communication devices (mobile phones, smart watches, headphones and other means of communication), electronic computers, programmable calculators, photo, audio and video equipment, reference materials, written notes made on any medium, and other means of storing and transmitting information, except for special means of storage and transmission of information.
- 9.7. The use of materials, items and means specified in paragraph 9.6 of the Regulations is prohibited both in the auditorium and in the whole building throughout the Olympiad until the end of the time allotted for the performance of the Olympiad task.
- 9.8. If there are signs indicating that a competitor has unauthorised materials, items and means listed in clause 9.6 of the Regulations, the organiser may demand to show them if available or demonstrate their absence. The competitor is obliged to comply with the organiser's request. In case of

refusal the organiser has the right to suspend the participant from further participation in the Olympiad of the current year without the right to appeal the decision.

- 9.9. Participants of the final stage in the profile 'Mathematics' are prohibited to use any calculators.
- 9.10. Upon expiry of the set time the participants must stop performing the task, otherwise it is considered as a violation of the rules of participation in the Olympiad.
- 9.11. The organisers accept the work of a participant for inspection upon presentation of an identity document. In the absence of an identity document, the work shall be handed in, but shall not be subject to inspection.
- 9.12. In the auditorium a participant is allowed to carry only a transparent plastic bottle (not more than 500 millilitres) with non-carbonated mineral water, chocolate in a non rustling package, medicines
- 9.13. The participants of the final stage perform their work only with a black gel pen. It is forbidden to do the work with a biro or a pen of another colour. The work must be neatly designed and written in clear handwriting. Corrections in the work are not allowed.
- 9.14. If necessary, a participant may leave the auditorium no more than 2 times and for no more than 6 minutes accompanied by an observer.
- 9.15. Upon presentation of a health certificate, the requirements specified in paragraph 9.14 may be revised in favour of the participant.
- 9.16. It is allowed to leave the classroom one hour after the start of the Olympiad. Participants are not allowed to leave the classroom 30 minutes before the end of the Olympiad.
 - 9.17. Participants of the final stage have the right to hand in their work early.
- 9.18. The participant of the final stage has the right to pick up the Olympiad task only after the end of the Olympiad time.
- 9.19. If a participant violates the Rules of Conduct of the participants during the final stage of the Olympiad, the authorised officials of the Olympiad organiser shall draw up an act on the violation and on the failure of the participant to pass the respective stage of the Olympiad, and if the Olympiad is held in person, they shall also remove the participant from the venue of the Olympiad. In case the fact of violation of the Rules of Conduct of the participants during the final stage of the Olympiad becomes known after the end of the respective stage of the Olympiad, but before the final results of the stage of the Olympiad are approved, the participant of the Olympiad may be disqualified and his/her result cancelled on the basis of the minutes of the Jury of the Olympiad with the decision to disqualify the participant of the Olympiad.

10. Amendments to the Rules

- 10.1. At the end of the final stage of the Olympiads, the Organising Committee collects the completed works, codifies them and submits them to the responsible coordinator not later than 2 days from the day of the final stage of the Olympiads.
- 10.2. The checked works are published in the personal accounts of the participants on the next day after the rating lists for each profile. The works done by the participants of the profiles 'Design' and 'Informatics' are available only on request.
- 10.3. The responsible coordinator hands the encrypted works to the jury, the jury checks, evaluates and scans them within 10 to 20 working days.
- 10.4. For each completed task a score is given in points. The maximum number of points for each profile is 100. The maximum number of points for the 'Informatics' profile is 500.
 - 10.5. Drafts are not encrypted or checked.
- 10.6. The Organising Committee together with the Jury prepares a draft protocol with the results and rating lists of the participants based on the sum of points received by the participant for completing the Olympiad tasks on the basis of the checked works.
 - 10.7. The protocols with the results are approved by the chairman and members of the Jury.

- 10.8. The Organising Committee shall publish the rating lists of the participants for each Olympiad profile on the Olympiad website no later than 25 working days from the day of the final stage.
- 10.9. Applications for appeal shall be accepted within three days from the date of publication of the ranking lists of participants.
- 10.10. Appeals are accepted only from the e-mail accounts registered in the personal account on the Olympiad website.
 - 10.11. Appeals will only be accepted in Word or PDF format.
- 10.12. After the Appeal Commission has conducted the appeal procedure, the Jury prepares final protocols signed by the Jury members and the Jury President, determines the candidates for winners and prize-winners.
 - 10.13. The complete package of documents shall be sent to the Organising Committee.
 - 10.14. The results of the final stage of the Olympiad are published on the Olympiad website.
- 10.15. The final protocols of the Olympiads shall be published on the Olympiad website no later than March 29, 2024.

12.1. Amendments and additions to these Regulations shall be made by approving a new version of the Regulations or by issuing an order of KFU on amendments and additions to the Regulations.

13. Final provisions

13.1. These Regulations shall be registered in the Document Management and Control Department. These Regulations shall be subject to mandatory distribution, which shall be carried out by the Document Management and Control Department in accordance with the procedure defined by the KFU Office Management Instruction.
